MEMORANDUM

The Court, after reviewing the motion and arguments of counsel, makes the following ruling on the plaintiff's Motion for Sanctions (motion):

The motion is **GRANTED**; the Court finds that the portion of the petition stating a cause of action against defendant Pitney-Bowes, Inc., was groundless. The Court **ORDERS** that plaintiff pay the sum of \$10,000.00 to defendant Pitney Bowes, Inc., as a sanction. The Court finds that the award of any higher amount, under the circumstances of this case, would be unjust.

The Court **ORDERS** that the above levied sanction be paid on or before the 13th day of February, 2009.

Defendant Pitney-Bowes, Inc., is instructed to prepare an order consistent with this memorandum and submit it to the Court no later than the 29th day of August, 2008.
